Item No. 1. Section 00100-Instruction to Bidders, Paragraph 3. Qualifications of Bidders, Subparagraph 3.1a. and sub-paragraph 3.3

In lieu of providing financial and corporate information required in sub-paragraph 3.1.a, the bidder may alternatively provide a letter indicating the bidder is pre-qualified with the Georgia Department of Transportation to perform work described in this bid request. This also applies to the first 2 bullets in sub-paragraph 3.3.

Item No. 2. No critical path schedule will be required.

Item No.3. The leveling and overlay of East Wesley Chapel Road will run from Mosely Road to Duke Road.

Item No. 4. Peach County understands the volatility in the asphalt materials market. Contracts will be awarded as soon as practical.

Item No. 5. Each project area has a specific time frame for construction. Each project area is a stand-alone project. Construction times will run concurrently.

Item No. 6. Contractors are to follow GDOT Specifications for lane closures. There are no restrictions.

- **Item No. 7.** Contractors are to use the GDOT 2021 Standard Specifications for this project.
- **Item No. 8.** No temporary Facilities are required.
- **Item No. 9.** Include the cost for Temporary Pavement Markings on the newly paved roads in the Traffic Control item.
- **Item No. 10.** Please use the attached road paving list for RFB 22-005.
- **Item No. 11.** Please use the revised maps attached.
- **Item No. 12.** The project will be awarded based on the procedure as outlined in the bid documents.
- **Item No. 13.** We are following GDOT Specifications to give us a good specification to construct this project. All bidders do not have to be GDOT qualified to bid.
- **Item No. 14.** Please use the revised Bid Forms attached. We have added a pay item for the project area: GDOT Grading per mile typical. We also have included a detail for this item.
- **Item No. 15.** Final stabilization with permanent grassing and mulching for this item, we are looking for the contractor to hydroseed the area backfilled under grading per mile. Include all items needed to generate a permanent stand of grass.


