Outdoor Warning Siren Specifications

Peach County will be accepting bids on the purchase of, and turnkey installation of 10 Whelen Vortec sirens. All bids must include the following:

- 1. 10 Whelen Vortex 129dBc sirens with weather resistant pole mount cabinets.

SECTION 3.0 - Specifications

- 3.1 PURPOSE. This bid is for the purchase and installation of one (1) Storm Sentry Automatic Siren Activation & Messaging System. The attached specifications are being provided to potential bidders as guidelines which describe the minimum type and quality of the equipment that Peach County is seeking to purchase. The bidder must submit documentation with the bid listing any exceptions to the specifications. It will be assumed that the bidder will fully comply with the minimum specifications if no exceptions are submitted. Failure to comply with this provision shall be cause for rejection of the bid.
- 3.2 GENERAL. The objective of this bid is to provide for the procurement of a complete Storm Sentry Automatic Siren Activation & Messaging System capable of Automatic activation of the County's current siren system utilizing the National Weather Service's Polygon System and send out text messages to defined portable devices. The system must also be compatible with the FEMA IPAWS System. Any omission in the specifications of any item essential to the delivery of a fully operational system does not alleviate the successful bidder from furnishing such.
- 3.3 All prospective bidders will conduct an on-site survey of the County to determine the best location of the system
- 3.4 All bids will include "turn-key" installation. Including any and all miscellaneous parts and labor necessary to create a complete and working storm warning system.

- 3.5 The County will provide Internet Access at the systems chosen location.
- 3.6 All proposals will be 100% compatible with the current radio system or will include the necessary equipment and or labor to make the system 100% compatible, at the bidder's expense.
- 3.7 Warranty for the Automatic Activation & Messaging System and workmanship, will be clearly stated.
- 3.8 The time necessary to complete the project is of major importance to the County. From date of order, each bidder will specify the amount of time that it will take to complete 100% of the project.

Software must accept data streams from the National Weather Service to monitor severe weather. Software must be capable of individual, zone, or full siren system activation. Software must be capable of automatic activation via EMWIN. Software must include IPAWS integration. Software must be a one-time purchase; no subscription or annual renewal plans will be accepted. Lifetime technical support and software updates must be included in the original purchase price. On-site training of County personnel must be included in the purchase price. Remote assistance must be included in the purchase

price. The System shall use two independent sources for data reception. One data stream must be satellite based and operate on one of the three available NOAA GOES Satellites (GOES 13, 14, or 15).

Greetings Prospective Vendor,

Georgia law has made it mandatory that all private employers enroll in and use the federal E-Verify system, not only for public contractors (including subcontractors and sub-subcontractors) providing labor to public projects, but also those companies providing services of any kind over \$2,499.99 in value, regardless of the number of employees a contractor has.
