Question: I'm looking at Solicitation No. 24-DES-ITBPW-646 - On-Call Construction of Wet Utilities, and see a couple items have the same description with different Line Item Numbers (Master ID Number). For Example:

02550-C6-00430	16" x 16" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box
02550-C6-00440	16" x 12" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box
02550-C6-00450	16" x 8" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box
02550-C6-00460	16" x 16" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box
02550-C6-00470	16" x 12" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box
02550-C6-00480	16" x 8" Tap/Sleeve On Iron Pipe, Valve & Valve Box

Can you tell me where I can find the exact description of the Line Item Numbers please? Thank you in advance for your assistance.

Answer: Line items 02550-C6-00460, 02550-C6-00470, 02550-C6-00480 are duplicates items and have been removed. Please see updated

Question: Line-Item Number 02500-C4-00930 24" RCP CL. IV, In Place > 10'. Is there a depth limit that should be bid to? i.e what is the deepest depth we should consider? This is applicable to several line-items numbers similarly labeled.

Answer: Please refer to Section 02500 Gravity Sewers and appurtenances 3.2 Depth and Cover of Pipe.

2. Line-Item Number 02500-C4-01182.  $53'' \times 34''$  Elliptical Pipe (48'' Equivalent), RCP CL. III, In Place > 6' Deep. Is this item for each vertical foot of depth over 6'? This question is applicable to several line-item number similarly labeled.

Answer: This line item is for linear feet installed for 53" x 34" Elliptical Pipe, RCP CL III, in Place >6' Deep. Per Section 02500, Part 4.1 - Sewer pipe for the various materials, classes, and sizes shown on the plans shall be measured in linear feet along the center line of the pipe and shall be measured from inside wall of structure to inside wall of structures. Payment shall include the furnishing of all pipe and fittings, all necessary tests, excavation, removal and disposal of existing pipes, removal and disposal of unsuitable or surplus material, placement of bedding and backfill as shown in Standard M-3.0, restoration of roadways as shown in Standard M-6.1, all other restoration, and all other work required to providing a complete sewer installation in compliance with the Construction Documents.

3. For the box culvert line-item numbers 02500-C4-03230 thru 02500-C4-03400. Is there a vertical depth of cover to be considered bid these items?

Answer: The vertical depth of cover will depend on the task order, however the line item covers depths up to 25' feet fill.

4. For line-item numbers 02550-C6-00540 and 02550-C6-00545. Abandon and Remove Existing Water Mains (All sizes and depths). Are there depth limits to bid for these items? What would be the maximum depth?

Answer: There are no depth limits for these items. Abandoning and removing existing water mains would be based on the task order and existing conditions.

5. For line-item number 02510-C7-00030 Sanitary Sewer – 8" PVC, SDR 26, Depth greater than or equal to 14'. Is there a depth limit for this item to bid to? This is applicable to several line-item numbers similarly labeled.

Answer: Refer to Section 02500 - 3.2 Depth and Cover of Pipe 3.2E - PPP shall not be installed at depths greater than 20' without special design analysis.

6. Can the Builders Risk insurance requirement be waived?

Answer: Not at this time
