The following are amendments to the Invitation for Bid #299-17 Construction Services for the

- 1. The Addendum release date has been extended one day to allow for answer a question in relation to the requirement and sizes of the back flow preventer and related items. Addendum #2 will be released by close of business November 3, 2017.
- 2. Scope of work has been added to the required work in the IFB document. The attached drawing on page 3 addresses the power to feed pump house and pumps.
- 3. All other dates, terms and conditions of the IFB remain the same.

The following are questions and answers to the invitation for Bid #299-17 Construction Services for the Veterans Memorial Pool House:

QUESTION: Please clarify whether the Owner or Contractor will be replacing and reworking the fencing around the pool deck.

ANSWER: Fence at outside covered porch (7) and gate in the concession area and fence at the entrance and its gates are to have core slab to set termination posts and are to be completed by the Contractor. The Contractor is also responsible for the temporary security fence during construction.

QUESTION: Is there a civil sheet?

Veterans Memorial Pool House:

ANSWER: No.

QUESTION: Is a back flow preventer and double check valve required?

ANSWER: No.

QUESTION: What size are the underground utility pipes?

ANSWER: 2" water.

QUESTION: Is a water meter required?
ANSWER: No
QUESTION: Is the water paid for by the City or us if required?
ANSWER: None.
QUESTION: If none of the above are required, what are the utility connection sizes and where are we making them in relation to the building footprint?
ANSWER: 5' beyond the building.
QUESTION: Has a compaction test been done at existing site?
ANSWER: A compaction test has not been done but, will be completed by the County prior to setting the footings.
QUESTION: Has a soil an analysis been done? Will we need to import proper soil for compaction?
ANSWER: A soil analysis has not been completed. If it is determined to be required, a change order would be issued.
QUESTION: Has a site survey been done that shows existing and new elevations in regards to pool deck?
ANSWER: No. The contractor shall tie to the existing pool deck elevation.
