REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 24-DPR-RFP-632

ADDENDUM NO. 1

Arlington County's Request for Proposals No. 24-DPR-RFP-632 for On-Call Comprehensive Park Planning Consultant Services is amended as follows:

- 1. Reference Section V. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS, 7. <u>PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL ELEMENTS</u>, D. <u>OFFEROR'S QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE</u>, is hereby changed to correct a) ii) as follows:
 - D. <u>OFFEROR'S QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE (40 Points)</u> << Page Limit: 1 page (text), 1 graphic page per project>>

The Offeror must have extensive experience in comprehensive park planning and analysis, park master planning and conceptual design, geospatial analysis and mapping, implementing equitable public engagement strategies, and knowledge of innovative planning and design trends and best practices. The Offeror must have verifiable experience and knowledge of local, state, and federal policies, plans, standards, and regulations.

The Offeror shall describe its qualifications and experience to perform the work described in this Request for Proposal by demonstrating representative projects using the following format.

- a) Provide a minimum of five relevant, comprehensive park planning projects that were conducted within the last ten years from the issuance date of this RFP. Referenced projects shall demonstrate the Contractor's applicable skills and experience to perform the work described above successfully and as required under the scope of solicitation. The listing of completed projects shall include the following:
 - i) Describe the scope of the project and elaborate on the type of services the firm provided (i.e., Comprehensive Park Planning, Park Needs Assessment, Park Master Planning, Conceptual Design Services, Community Engagement, etc.). If other firms were involved, describe their roles.
 - ii) Note which categories from sub-sections b through f below, if any, each project is being submitted to satisfy.
 - iii) Provide execution time (contract/actual); cost (estimated/actual) and an explanation for any variances.
 - iv) Describe any challenges encountered during project duration and describe how your firm overcame such challenges.
 - v) Describe the public engagement strategies employed to obtain community buy-in and support for a specific project.
 - vi) Provide each client's contact information, including name, organization, telephone number, email address, and copies of any awards or commendations received for the

- referenced projects.
- vii) Provide links to and/or graphic work samples such as illustrative renderings and/or photographs of the completed work.
- b) Of the five projects described above, at least one project shall demonstrate the Offeror's prior experience in comprehensive park planning and needs assessment.
- c) Of the five total projects described above, at least one shall demonstrate the Offeror's prior experience developing park master plans and conceptual park/public space designs.
- d) Of the five total projects described above, at least one shall demonstrate the Offeror's prior experience conducting statistically valid needs assessment surveys.
- e) Of the five total projects described above, at least one project shall demonstrate the Offeror's prior experience in geospatial analysis and mapping.
- f) Of the five total projects described above, at least one project shall demonstrate the Offeror's prior experience in developing, designing, and executing public outreach and engagement approaches.
- g) Provide contact information for three local jurisdictions for which your firm has provided comprehensive park planning services in the past ten years. At a minimum, provide the following information:
 - i) Name of an individual from that jurisdiction who can provide information regarding the quality of services offered by your firm.
 - ii) Contact person's current email address and phone number.

The following clarifications are made as a result of vendor inquiries:

1. For Proposal Submittal Element D. Offerer's Qualifications and Experience, could you clarify which categories item a) ii) is referencing? It appears to possibly correspond to items b through f rather than a) ii through vii. Thank you.

County's Response: See above in Addendum No. 1 for correction.

2. For Section E. Experience of the Project Team, does the 2-page limit for the summary include all items in subsection 3 (minus subcontractor resumes)?

County's Response: Section E. Experience of the Project Team: The 2-page limit is for a summary of the entire team. The 1-page limit could be used to include a profile of each team (including each subcontractor) and a 1-page resume per each staff.

The balance of the solicitation remains unchanged.
