This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Request for Proposal for the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

1. Questions and Answers:

Q1: Will they be adding Directional Bores to the Pay Items as there are none at this time? A1: There are no directional bores in this project. The intent is that all of the lighting/ITS conduit be installed by an open cut while the contractor has the streets and sidewalks demolished.

Q2: Note 31 says to add 1 spare 3" conduit to every bore with a pull box will these pull boxes be added to the pay items or be incidental to the bores?

A2: Since there are no bores in the project it will <u>not</u> be required to install the additional 3" conduit and pull box.

Q3: Note 37 talks about walls and bridges and working with the structural contractor. Are there to be any light pole pilasters on this project?

A3: There are no walls or bridges in the project so there will be no structural engineer required. There are no light pole pilasters on the project – the poles are attached to a galvanized plate within the sidewalk. Refer to the "Typical Pole Detail" on sheet RL-13. Sheet RL-5 details the luminaire in the legend.

2. All other terms and conditions remain the same.
