### **Questions and Answers**

After review of the plant list, the following species are not commercially available:

Tropical fimbry

Marsh fimbry

Sea blite

1. Perennial saltmarsh aster

Annual glasswort

Perennial glasswort

Please advise if higher quantities of other species on your list can be substituted for the above listed species.

**No, with the exception of those higher quantities specified in #2, below. We will consider other suggested species as possible substitutions for those. 2. Can *Iva imbricata* (Beach Elder) be used in place of *Fimbristylis cymosa* and *Fimbristylis spadiacea*?

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**No, this is not a type for type substitution.**

3. Can Misc. Argusia gnaphaloides (Sea Lavender) be used in place of Limonium carolinianum?

**No, this is not a type for type substitution.**

4. Can BR1000-L4 Paspalum vaginatum (Seashore Paspalum) be used in place of Paspalum distichum and Paspalum vaginatum?

**Yes, this substitution is acceptable.**

5. Can Misc. Ernodea Littoralis (Beach Creeper) be used in place of sub for Suaeda linearis?

**No, this is not a type for type substitution.**

6. Can Misc. Monarda Punctata (Spotted Beebalm) be used in place of Symphyotrichum tenuifolium?

**No, this plant is not suitable as a substitution.**

7. Can BR1311-L4 Salicornia virginica (Perennial Glasswort) be used in place of Salicornia bigelowii and Salicornia virginica?

**Yes, this substitution is acceptable.**

8. Are there other substitutions the County would like to propose?

**No substitutions are proposed by the County.**

9. How much time has been allotted for the project completion once it has started? If this has been determined, we would appreciate knowing the timeframe that is expected.

**The schedule for the project will be refined once a General Contractor has been selected. It is anticipated that the wetland construction will be the first element to be constructed, and we anticipate that this work will be completed within 4 to 6 months of construction commencement.**
