- SECTION II SCOPE OF SERVICES, C, 3, A) "LABOR DAY" IS CHANGED TO "MEMORIAL DAY".
- THE COUNTY HAS RECEIVED QUESTIONS IN RESPONSE TO THIS ITB. QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - Question 1: Do you want the cert for "confined spaces" in with the bid papers?
 Response 1: Yes, we would like the certifications to be included with the bid papers.
 - Question 2: Do you want copies of certs from the techs who are taking the pool readings included in the bid papers?
 - Response 2: Yes, we would like the certifications to be included with the bid papers.
 - Question 3: Are we inspecting a total of 4 (four) back flow preventors- one for each facility? And 4 electrical inspection?
 - Response 3: The county will certify the backflow preventers and the successful contractor is required to complete the electrical inspections with the exception of James Hunter, dog park.
 - Question 4: Were the chemical probes protected during the winter shut down? Or left in place at facility?
 - Response 4: The chemical probes are removed during winter and stored onsite or depending on location.
 - Question 5: Was the county prepared to reinstall the 2 motors from Mosaic fountain?
 Response 5: The county is prepared to reinstall the motors at Mosaic.
 - Question 6: Are any of the holding or storage units "underground vats" leaking? was last inspection in Sept. 2022?
 - Response 6: We are not aware of any leaking under water vaults.
 - Question 7: Is there a current list of inventory from the preceding season 2022? And is it available to vendor?
 - Response 7: An inventory list is not available from the 2022 preceding season.

- Question 8: In 3a- opening- I believe you mean "Memorial Day and not Labor Day?
 Response 8: Correct, this should read Memorial Day and will be updated in the scope of work.
- O Question 9: Does Penrose use bromine or chlorine?

Response 9: Penrose Square IWF uses Bromine.

 Question 10: Each location is to have an administrative book (or maintenance book) and a Log book for readings- Is this correct? Or are we to also have a communication book?

Response 10: Yes, each location has a log per the Health Department requirements. The logs containing water quality test results for a year.

- Question 11: Can the Arlington County persons who showed us the facility be the same ones we contact for tutoring the water on in the beginning of summer?
 - Response 11: We have an Arlington representative that will assist with the opening process and thru the term of the contract, which will be provided after award.
- Question 12: Assuming all chems. on property can be used?
 Response 12: The successful bidder will be responsible to supply all chemicals. Reference Section II, Scope of Service, paragraph B,2.
- Question 13: Is it know if Arlington Health dept. is going virtual as Fairfax is doing?
 Response 13: Successful Bidder will have to check with Arlington Health Department to follow their requirements.
- Question 14: If so do we register with a portal?
 Response 14: The Arlington Health Department have their own process separate from the Department of Parks and Recreation.
