

E-Rate Fiscal Year 2017 Category 2 Equipment RFP Q&A

Round Three Revised- April 17th, 2017

Here are the answers after the walkthroughs on 4/17/17.

1. For Sand Creek Elementary School, is this a total re-cable? If so, will the old data be converted to voice and the old voice cable removed?

No, this is not a full re-cable. They're going to keep the old data cables for now.

2. Are there any new WAPs for the elementary schools?

No, there are no new WAP's for the elementary schools.

3. For all the schools, will low voltage cut-ins need to be provided by the contractor for the added data locations?

Yes, if needed for walls made of drywall.

4. Is there an estimate of how many new data cables will be added to existing locations?

Yes, the exact numbers are in the RFP.

5. Is the plan to use all new patch panels or fill in the existing openings and add patch panels as necessary?

All new patch panels.

6. For the high school WAPs, are the counts in addition to the existing WAPs, or are the existing cables to be abandoned for new cabling, or do we remove the existing RJ45 plugs and re-terminate with cat6 jacks?

Remove the existing RJ45 plugs and terminate into the biscuit, and then connect the new access point with a patch cable.

7. Will the contractor be responsible mounting the WAPs?

Yes, the contractor will be responsible for mounting the new WAP's at the high schools.

8. Are any of the WAPs in areas that will need some kind of enclosure?

Yes, one for each access point at the high schools in the gym.

9. Will you accept a cabling-only bid for section 2, with the devices and hardware provided by others?

Yes.
