A. Please see the following:

- 1. The bid opening date has been changed to Monday, 2:00pm, September 23, 2019.
- 2. **Working Hours:** All Work at the site shall be performed daily, including weekends from the hours of 7:00 am until 7:00 pm. No additional expenses shall be granted for work performed after hours. Contractor is not permitted to perform work on any District observed holiday, without the written consent of the District Project Manager. Detailed work schedule shall be determined in advance at the preconstruction meeting.
- 3. A licensed roofing contractor, building contractor or general contractor can submit their bid for this project.
- 4. Questions 5 & 6 below: The new drip edge and flashing are already a part of the Construction Docs and that work would be included in line #4 of the schedule of bid prices.
- 5. Any requests for substitutions shall be in accordance with Section III, Item 14.

B. Please see the following responses to questions for clarification:

- 1. Question: Subcontractor Participation Requirement Page 62 section 6.4 of the above referenced ITB states that "It is the intention of this bid not to subcontract work. However, if a vendor must subcontract, they may not subcontract any more than 25% of any portion of this contract for any reason." Please advise if this requirement can be waived?
 - Answer: No, Subcontractor Participation Requirement cannot be waived.
- Question: Vertical Stucco Surfaces Drawings show painting of horizontal stucco surfaces only (Ref: Note # 5). During the site visit, we noticed. Please confirm that existing vertical stucco surfaces would also get painted to match?
 - **Answer:** Yes, paint the vertical stucco areas to match the horizontal stucco areas.
- 3. Question: Note #5 Cafeteria Note # 5 is not referenced in Cafeteria Elevations. Please advise.
 - Answer: Note #5 shall apply to the stucco areas above the banding, as well as the vertical stucco areas below the banding.
- **4. Question: Unforeseen Conditions** Should an allowance be carried for unforeseen concealed conditions behind fascia (i.e. wood rot repair, etc.)?
 - Answer: Submit price in accordance with the revised bid schedule attached. .
- 5. Question: SS Drip Edge Detail 4 sheet A 401, shows new stainless steel drip edge at existing standing seam metal roof, this drip edge cannot be properly installed without removing a portion of the existing roof. Please advise if existing drip edge is to remain?
 - Answer: Please include a price for replacing the existing drip edge as noted in the contract documents.
- 6. Question: Existing Metal Flashing During the site visit, it was observed that an existing metal flashing exists behind the foam band. Please advise if we are to leave this metal flashing in place and install new SS flashing over top?
 - **Answer:** Please remove the existing flashing and install new flashing.
- 7. Question: Additional Details Please provide details for the following additional conditions observed during site visit.



Answer: a. Typical Flashing Detail where yellow bricks meets stucco. See detail 6/A-401 as yellow brick appears to be in the same plane as the red brick.

b. Typical Flashing Detail at existing recessed notches in brick wall. Detail 6/A-401 is similar as the flashing will bridge the recessed notches

c. Typical Flashing Detail at vertical stucco locations. See detail 6/A-401 for all standard brick to stucco locations where the brick is out of plane with the stucco.
