Questions/Clarifications and Answers:

The following question(s) (shown in italicized text) were submitted by prospective bidder(s). The City's responses are presented here (shown in bold text). The submitters' names and email addresses have been removed due to privacy requirements.

- 1. The pump at Terramar Park is not 100% on the slab. Is a new concrete slab needed?*
No. The small area not concreted has the main pipe access for work repairs as needed.
- 2. Are there shop drawings available? How will work be done without drawings?*
No. There are no shop drawings to be distributed with the ITB. The Notice to Proceed (NTP) will be 45 days after the approved shop drawings are provided to the awarded vendor.

3. *Who is responsible for the permit fee?*

The City will provide an allowance of up to \$1,000.00 for the City required permits.

4. *How are contractor's expected to access the pump at Terramar as it was noted that there is a fence and bushes around the pump.*

The City prefers the selected vendor go over the fence and hedge. If the vendor removes any hedges in order to complete the work, the vendor will be responsible to replace and return the site to its original condition.

5. *If the Vendor goes over the fence and hedge, is there a need for a mode of transportation (MOT) in order to bring in the proper equipment?*

No as the road is a residential, two-lane road. The City would only require a few cones.

6. *What is the budget for this?*

The budget is \$45,000. However, this may not properly reflect the current marketplace condition. The budget will be adjusted accordingly. Please price according to the specifications.

7. *What are the ages of the pumps?*

The pump at Terramar Whittier Oaks is 12 years old. The pump at the Public Safety site is 18 years old.

8. *What is required – the Horsepower or the Flow?*

The pump at Terramar Whittier Oaks requires 15 hp; the pump at Public Safety required 7.5 hp. Please see additional specification for minimum requirements.

9. *The pump station at Terramar Park is called out in the bid as a 15HP Goulds pump producing 225GPM @108PSI. During the inspection of the pump station we found that the existing pump is a 15HP pump producing 65PSI. The station has a single pump installed with no Jockey/Pressure Maintenance pump. Does the City want the station replaced with similar configuration? Or does the city want an upgraded pump station as to what is called out in the specification that I have attached.*

The City would like a similar configuration to the existing pump station. Please see additional specification for minimum requirements.
