Fire Alarm Inspection, Testing, and Repair**

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to RFP 22-R0005 for Fire Alarm Inspection Testing, and Repair, dated July 21, 2021, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory pre-proposal conference.

- All Offerors are encouraged to visit each building to confirm all specifications. This will be especially important in the Purchasing Division/Equipment Maintenance facility, as well as the Warren S. Gall Police Annex (due to recent construction.)
- When visiting facilities, please announce your presence and intentions to the front desk staff. Please be mindful of programs and meetings that may be occurring at the time of your visit.
- The difference between a bid and a proposal involves evaluation factors. In a bid situation, decisions are made solely on price. In a proposal situation, factors other than price are considered, such a technical approach, experience, certifications, licensing, etc.
- A responsive proposal must include both the RFP document and the accompanying Statement of Work, submitted in the same envelope. Failure to submit both documents will be just cause to declare the Offeror non-responsive.
- Each page of the Statement of Work must be completed in its entirety, and then transferred to the summary pages at the end of the document. If there is any discrepancy between the pages of the Statement of Work and the summary pages, then the information on the bottom of each page of the Statement of Work will take priority over information on the summary pages.
- At the Law Enforcement Center, additional permits from both the state and local fire marshals will be necessary.
- No time extensions will be given on this solicitation. Additional questions are due no later than 12:00 noon (local time) on Thursday, August 5, 2021. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to asowers@cityofmyrtlebeach.com All questions received by the deadline will be answered via addendum.
- Alarm monitoring is **NOT** covered by this solicitation. Any information regarding alarm monitoring must be directed to Deputy Chief Thomas VanDemark at 843-918-1105. No information regarding alarm monitoring should be submitted as part of the proposal package.

- Sealed proposals are due in the Purchasing Office no later than 2:00PM (local time) on Thursday, August 12, 2021. No e-mail submissions will be accepted. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.
- The mandatory conference sign-in sheet is attached and is hereby made part of this addendum.
