BACKGROUND: Council at your August 20, 2019 meeting appointed a Committee to review the qualifications for Professional Engineering Services for the West Lake Jackson Infrastructure upgrades. The committee consisted of Mayor Shoop, Councilmember Carlisle, City Administrator Noethlich, Utility Director Boggus and Public Works Director Fields.

At Council’s October 15, 2019 meeting Council accepted the committee’s recommendation to negotiate a contract with CivilSurv Design Group. The purpose of this Agenda Item Summary is to update Council on the status of the Lakeview Drive Infrastructure Project and the State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program which will be the major source of funding.

II. State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program.....Mark Brewer

- The program is essentially a low interest loan, typically less than 1% for construction. The SRF financing has multiple steps as follows:
 - Request for Inclusion (RFI) Planning
 - Request for Inclusion (RFI) submitted December 2019 (See Attachment A)
 - City approved for a Planning Loan Allocation of \$225,000 (See Attachment B)
 - Loan Application Planning
 - Facility Plan Completed
 - Facility Plan approved by FDEP
 - Loan Application or Amendment Design
 - Engineering Design Completed
 - Engineering approved by FDEP
 - Permitting and Site Certifications
 - Request for Inclusion Construction
 - Loan Application Construction
 - Bids for Construction
 - Bids approved by FDEP
 - Construction
 - Administrative Closeout
