- 1. Is the on site tank a temporary tank for your use in case your tank is not operational? Does the tank have to be a certain size?

 Yes. The temporary tanks would need to be at least 1,000 gallon tank for gasoline and a 3,000 gallon tank for diesel. The tank that they will put the gasoline and/or diesel in, is already on-site and it is owned by the County. Vendors will need to pump off into those specific tanks. On-site could also mean, if we are out on a job and need fuel, that they would be able to come to us, where we are currently working.
- 2. Stand by Truck. Please clarify what that means? where specifically in the bid is this "stand by truck"? If it is #8 on page 3, that means "to have a tank or fuel tanker on stand by for emergency issues
