1. At the bottom of Page 3 of the attached PDF – it says <u>"Vendors are reminded to review section 1.11 of the Terms and Conditions for State of Tennessee Contractors' License Law requirements."</u>

Looking at section 1.11 on Page 13 – it says <u>"Bids for which the total cost of the project is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25.000) or more, the outside of the sealed bid envelope/package containing the bid provides the following information: the Company Name, the Contractor's license number, license classification, the date of the license expiration and that part of each license classification applying to the bid."</u>

Answer: A contractor's license is not required for this bid.

2. Please see our attached Terms and Conditions which is part of our Sales Contract – which will be required to be signed/returned by Anderson County as we process paperwork regarding sale.

Answer: The County may review terms and conditions after bid opening and before bid award but not during the bid process.

3. payment terms are 1/3 due upon signing of Sales Contract, 1/3 due when building is released into production, remaining 1/3 due upon delivery.

Answer: The County does not agree to these payment terms.
