1.	What percentage of the Chromebook 3189s are fully functional and working?	They are not separated. Do not have info.
2.	What percentage have broken screens?	They are not separated. Do not have info.
3.	What percentage have physical damage i.e. broken hinges, non-working ports, bad batteries etc.?	They are not separated. Do not have info.
4.	Would the boxes the Chromebooks are in hold up to shipping if we had them skidded and wrapped? Are these the boxes your replacement machines came in?	They are in banker boxes – 18 per box on pallets. Vendor will have to determine if they would hold up in shipping.
5.	What percentage of the power adapters are fully functional and working?	They are not separated. Do not have info.
6.	The document says Serial numbers and pictures can be provided upon request. Can you please provide these both?	Intel Celeron N4020 (Dual Core, up to 2.8GHz, 4M Cache, 6W) 4GB 2400MHz LPDDR4 Non-ECC 32GB eMMC Hard Drive 11.6" HD 1366 x 768 WVA 16:9 Touch with Corning(R) Gorilla(R) Glass. 7.	Are on-site visits to view the equipment allowed?	No
8.	Are the Chromebooks wiped and unlinked from your account?	Yes
9.	If we receive the equipment and any of the equipment is not unlinked from account, will you supply us the passwords to unlock?	Yes
10.	Are damage Chromebooks that are not working, unlinked from your account?	Yes

11.	It is stated that the devices are in boxes with 18 per box. What are the dimensions of these boxes and are they all on pallets? If on Pallets are they wrapped and ready to be removed?	The box dimensions are 28.75 x 7.5 x 17.5 inches. They are on pallets and wrapped.
12.	Does the school have a loading dock, or is a lift gate needed?	Lift gate needed.
13.	Can a pallet jack be used to remove the equipment from where it currently sits?	Yes
14.	As far as the condition of the devices, will they have any engravings, broken parts, or be completely broken? Is there anything specific about the condition of the device's bidders should know about?	The devices are all mixed – some are broken, and some are in working condition. We do not have them separated or numbers of each type.

16.	Will a deposit need to be submitted with the bid?	Full payment as per the requirements in the solicitation will be expected upon pickup.
