This addendum forms a part of and modifies the bidding specifications for the above item for the City of Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

ITEM 1 – Changes to Invitation and Instructions to Bidders

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Replace: #57 stone with

"crusher run" stone (TDOT Type A, Grade D) for the trail base.

ITEM 2 – Questions Received from Potential Bidders

1. The Scope of Work states the project is a GREENWAY Trail and preparation for Pedestrian Bridge. What needs to be done to prepare for future bridge abatements?

Answer: This is for trail only – nothing special for bridge but simply butting the trail to the city located bridge connection.

2. The conceptual plan shows benches, signage, court resurfacing, river stone in creek, riparian soil, site lighting, crosswalk etc. Is this Project ONLY the trail & widened rest areas as detailed in the Specifications?

Answer: Yes, remaining work items to be completed by others.

3. Is it possible to prepare a cross section of the trail showing the detail explained in the Specifications as "3" wide edging trim gravel/stone 3" in height"

Answer: Cross section of trail not available but can be hand sketched.

4. It appears the Guide Wire for the Utility Pole interferes in a location (or more) of the trail. Will this be re located by ORED?

Answer: That is the plan but it might be after trail is placed.
