

RESOLUTION NO. 18-272

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF BLUE TIGER POOLS, LLC d/b/a BLUE RIBBON POOLS FOR THE ANNUAL SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE AT THE BREAKERS PARK SPLASH PAD AND OCEANFRONT CLOCK TOWER FOUNTAIN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,120 FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT WITH BLUE TIGER POOLS, LLC d/b/a BLUE RIBBON POOLS CORRESPONDING TO THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S OPTIONS TO RENEW, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids were duly called and advertised for maintenance of the Breakers Splash Pad and Oceanfront Clock Tower; and

WHEREAS, bid opening was on May 21, 2018, the Bid Tabulation being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the bid submitted by Blue Tiger Pools, LLC d/b/a Blue Ribbon Pools, and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:

SECTION 2. The bid approved in Section 1 above is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the General Services Contract with Blue Tiger Pools, LLC d/b/a Blue Ribbon Pools, for the above-referenced services in accordance with the bid documents.

SECTION 4. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to return the bid security of all unsuccessful bidders in accordance with the terms of the bid documents.

SECTION 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to exercise the City's options to renew the above-referenced Contract, subject to budgeting and appropriation.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
