## Addendum #02 August 25, 2021

## RFP 22-R0007 Court Resurfacing at Midway Park

The purpose of this Addendum #02 to RFP 22-R0007 for Court Resurfacing at Midway Park, dated August 5, 2021, and previously amended on August 17, 2021, is to answer the following questions:

1. When does the City plan to dig and set the net posts and center anchors? This is usually done by work crews when laying out the court before the first resurfacing coat and crack repair.

The City will dig and set the net posts and center anchors after the Contractor has completed the scope of work.

2. Are you planning on a fence or divider net between the two sets of five pickle ball courts?

Yes, fencing is planned between the two sets of five pickle ball courts.

3. How old are the existing courts? Has there been any additional asphalt added since the original construction. And if so, when was this work done and by whom?

The age of the existing courts and information regarding additional asphalt is unknown.

4. What kind of warranty on the crack repair are you expecting? According to my measurements (over 2000 linear feet of cracks) this may need a new asphalt process.

Additional asphalt is not in the scope of work, and we will not be adding new asphalt. The City is willing to waive the warranty on crack repair, but all cracks must be repaired.

5. Would the City consider an asphalt overlay for a more long-term repair?

No, the City will not consider an asphalt overlay. Additional asphalt is not in the scope of work.

6. Would the City consider demolition of all existing areas to install new base and finish layers?

No, the City will not consider demolition as part of the scope of work.

7. Please clarify how you want to improve the large bird baths on the existing courts?

Plans for improvement of the large bird baths on the existing courts can be included in the Offeror's response to the RFP.

8. Please clarify how you would like the existing pickle ball and tennis court holes to be repaired (net post areas and center anchor areas.)

The City will be filling the pickle ball and tennis court holes.

9. Will the City be taking down the posts and nets on all courts? Are new posts and nets needed or will the existing ones be reinstalled? If existing posts are to be reused, what color paint should be used?

The City will be reinstalling the existing posts and nets. The posts will not be painted.

10. Will the Contractor need to provide the City with the PVC sleeves and center anchors?

No, the Contractor will not need to provide the City with the PVC sleeves and center anchors.

11. Would the City consider adding an additional 20 days to the completion date due to industry shortage of materials?

Yes, the City will consider adding an additional 20 days to the completion date due to industry shortage of materials.

12. Would the City consider paying for materials as soon as they are delivered?

No, the City will not consider paying for materials as soon as they are delivered.

13. Would the City consider adding another coat of resurfacer or color to the application process to do all the cracks and raised playing lines?

No, this is beyond the scope of work.

14. Will the City be removing benches and reinstalling them once work is completed?

Yes, the City will be removing benches and reinstalling them once the work is completed.

15. Will the courts be locked after daily work is completed?

Yes, the Contractor will have the ability to lock the gates every day after work is completed.

16. Please confirm that the City will take down and reinstall the basketball goals.

Yes, the City will take down and reinstall the basketball goals.

17. Can we just provide a certified cashier's check of \$25,000.00 in place of bonds?

Yes, a cashier's check in the amount of 5% of the total dollar amount of the proposal submitted, payable to the City of Myrtle Beach, is acceptable as a bid bond. A cashier's check is not acceptable for payment or performance bonds.

18. Please clarify the overall workmanship warranty you are expecting?

We are expecting a warranty on all resurfacing work and painting. This includes product manufacturer's warranty as well as proper application of product.

19. Where is the water source? Where is the power source?

The water source is beside the pickle ball pod. The power source is near the tennis court pod.

Sealed proposals are due no later than Thursday, September 2, 2021 at 2:00PM (local time.) No electronic submissions will be accepted. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.
