Addendum 01 August 12, 2019 RFP 20-R0004 Tennis Court Resurfacing

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to RFP 20-R0004 for Tennis Court Resurfacing, dated July 31, 2019, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory site visit and to answer related questions.

- Proper insurance and City of Myrtle Beach business license will be required before any work can begin. Additional questions pertaining to business licenses can be directed to 843-918-1200.
- A one percent (1%) increase based on the final amount as documented by the purchase order shall be given for every seven (7) consecutive calendar days that work is completed in advance of the established deadline of October 30, 2019. Calendar days will be calculated from the day of final acceptance by the City, up to and including the deadline date. No increase will be given for partial weeks (any amount of days that do not equal a full seven-day week.)
- Offerors will be held responsible only for product and workmanship warranties on the paint and coatings used to line the courts. If a manufacturer's warranty for the crack sealing product is available, a copy of it should be provided to the City. No further warranty on crack repair will be upheld.
- To reduce discoloration, as evidenced on the tennis balls seen at the meeting, Offeror must submit product maintenance requirements with their proposal.
- A bid bond is to be submitted with your proposal if the work exceeds \$25,000. Performance and payment bonds must be provided only by the Offeror selected for the job.
- The two (2) back courts already have orange ball lines, and those are to be restored as part of the project. In addition, Offerors may submit a separate line item in their pricing breakdown to add these orange ball lines to the other four (4) courts.
- Proposals are due in the Purchasing Office no later than 2:00PM (local time) on Monday, August 26, 2019. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail. No e-mail submissions will be accepted.
- The mandatory site visit sign-in sheet is attached and is hereby made part of this addendum.
