Schedule

Phasing of work must be coordinated with the Kelce College of Business Renovation and Expansion General Contractor. The General Contractor will set the schedule after the project is awarded. Demolition and phased abatement is anticipated to complete within the 2022 calendar year.

Mandatory Requirements

Abatement Contractor shall be licensed by the State of Kansas, Department of Health & Environment for abatement work; it is the responsibility of the Abatement Contractor to assure that all licenses are current and valid throughout the entirety of the job.

Abatement Contractor shall follow all OSHA, KDHE and other applicable codes, regulations and statutes for abatement.

Abatement Contractor shall meet all applicable requirements of federal, state and local entities and ordinances regarding the handling and disposal of abated materials.

Abatement Contractor shall complete abatement without contaminating existing materials and facilities.

Interested Abatement Contractors are encouraged to visit the site prior to price submittal. All are also invited to attend the Kelce Center College of Business Renovation General Contractor prebid meeting at 2PM, April 5th, in 119 Kelce. Abatement Contractor is responsible for ascertaining the extent of work to be completed.
