Clarification of Contract Documents and Specifications:

The following are responses to questions received from potential bidders:

Questions

1. Q: Will the contractor be allowed to close Fountain City Park for construction?

A: Yes, the contractor shall be allowed to close the park for up to 3 weeks to complete the work for Site 15a. During construction, the contractor shall maintain access to the Fountain City Lions Club Community Building on the northern end of the park.

2. Q: How many access points will the contractor have to Site 15a – Fountain City Park?

A: The contractor shall access the park through the gate off of Gresham Road.

Addition of Cooperative Purchases Clause
