This addendum is being published to respond to questions the City has received from potential bidders. The City's responses hereby become a part of the Contract Documents and modify the original specifications as noted below.

## **Questions Received:**

**Question #1:** What are the exact work hours for this project considering flagging and possible lane closure?

**Response #1:** Flagging and any possible lane closures will have to be between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm weekdays.

**Question #2:** The location of the existing catch basin where the tie in occurs, is this the actual location of the structure or will a new structure have to be placed next to it in order to tie in the new piping?

**Response #2:** We anticipate using the existing structure for the tie-in.

**Question #3:** The existing slopes that must be returned to original grades, some appear to be fairly steep (primarily the area adjacent to the new headwall) (steeper than 1:1) how can these be returned to existing grade without the use of retaining walls, etc.?

**Response #3:** Slopes should be returned as close to original grade a practical, but still maintaining the swale at the top of the slope.

Question #4: What is the anticipated start date for this project, if everything falls into place?

**Response #4:** We would like to start quickly. We anticipate it will take 30-45 days after bid opening to get a contract completed.
