SUBJECT: Addendum No. III to RFP - Electric Vehicle Charging Installation

PROPOSALS TO BE OPENED: June 1, 2022 at 11:00am Eastern Time

This addendum is being published to provide clarification regarding the above referenced RFP. This addendum becomes a part of the contract documents and modifies the original specifications as follows:

Item 1: Is the \$1095 permit cost a one-time fee, or is that the approx. monthly revenue expected?

Response: While the City expects an occupancy fee or compensation due to loss of revenue from metered parking, the City understands that compensation impacts the risk of investment of the proposers. With that in mind, we are open to suggestions on recommended solutions that may include direct payment, revenue sharing, or other potential solutions. Proposers should detail any alternative proposal or hardship in their proposal. In an effort to provide meaningful context on the loss of value of each metered parking stall in this location, the city projects the potential loss of revenue at a rate of approximately \$1,095 per 10-hr meter in the proposed footprint.
