**Question:** Q2. Is there an approved budget for this contract? How much is the budget?

**Clarification:** The budget is undetermined.

**Question:** Q3. What is the specific number of contracts to be issued under this solicitation?

**Clarification:** This will be determined during the qualifications evaluation process.

**Question:** Q4. Can we include resumes in an Appendix, or are they part of the 30-page limit?

**Clarification:** Resumes may be included within the 30-page limit.
