This amendment is to answer questions received. Please note, unless otherwise stated, all stipulations from the original solicitation apply. You must acknowledge all amendments on page #2 of the original bid form.

1. Is a bid bond required for this solicitation?

Please see II. INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS -- B. Special Instructions section of solicitation. Both Bid Bond and Performance Bond are required for this project.

2. Confirm all cabinet components to have plywood core.

Yes, we'd like cabinets to have a plywood core.

3. Confirm all sinks (epoxy and stainless) are by this contractor.

All sinks are to be provided as part of this contract.

4. Is science casework to receive a chemical resistant finish?

Yes, we'd like science casework to have a chemical resistant finish.

- 5. Are all services (water, gas, electric) to be disconnected and reconnected by this contractor? Yes, contractor is responsible for disconnecting/connecting fixtures.
  - 6. *Is acid resistant piping required at lab sinks?*

Acid resistant piping required in Chemistry Labs at Fort Mill High School.

7. Should 48" wide cabinets have 1" thick shelves?

Yes, shelves in 48" cabinets should be a minimum of 1" in thickness.

8. Can electric outlets at science labs be surface mounted?

Yes, outlets in labs can be surface mounted.

9. Can the drawer configuration at chemistry lab tables be (4) full width drawers?

Yes, drawer configuration can be (4) full width drawers.

10. Confirm submissions should be submitted online and not in person.

- Yes, these are all acceptable for the band room cabinets
- 12. Confirm all laminate tops to have plywood core.
