NOTES FROM THE PRE-BID MEETING

A Pre-Bid Meeting was held at the Development Resource Center, 1250 Market Street, Chattanooga, 37402, on November 15, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. The agenda and a sign-in sheet from the meeting is attached.

The following statement from the specifications was emphasized to the contractors present Make sure that section 00201-1 is completely filled out and is placed on the outside of the bid envelope on the bid opening date. If that form is not on the outside of the bid envelope, the bid will not be opened.

The summary of work from Section 01010and the bid schedule from each project was read. The summaries of work are presented below. The bid schedules have both been revised, and are attached separately.

R-16-015, Erwin Riverfront Marina Parking Lot

The work covered by this Contract consists of:

Regrade and compact existing parking lot and construct min. 4" stone and 4" asphalt parking lot (approx., 5,400sf). Reconstruct concrete apron and sidewalk and two ADA ramps. Remove and replace curb and gutter. Remove and reset pavers. Maintain and control traffic during construction as directed by City of Chattanooga Department of Transportation.

The Bid Schedule is attached separately.

R-17-002, Proposed Paving at Parks Maintenance Building

The work covered by this Contract consists of:

- 1. Partial excavation of gravel in the maintenance lot to determine the depth of existing gravel
- Removal and replacement of A/C pads, installation of bollards, adjustment of valve boxes and hand hold boxes, relocation of existing gas line to a deeper depth.

- 3. Removal of all or part of the existing gravel to accommodate a pavement section as specified in the plans and specifications.
- 4. Paving of the existing 10,500 s.f. maintenance lot east of the City Parks maintenance Office building.
- 5. Preparation and construction of a dumpster corral on the west side of the building at the rear of the existing asphalt parking lot, and related work.

The bid schedule is attached separately.

The following changes shall be made to the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Drawings:

- Please replace the bid schedule for R-16-015 (numbered starting at 00301AD7-2 in the footer) with the corrected one attached (Page numbering starting at 00301 Addendum 1 1).
- Please replace the bid schedule for R-17-002 (no page numbering) with the corrected one attached (Page numbering starting at 00301 Addendum 1 – 1). A new line item, "Construction of a new concrete pad for gas tank" was added, and items were renumbered.

The following questions were asked and discussed at the meeting.

Q1. Is there a preference as to which of the two projects is started first?

A1. The City would prefer that the work at Middle Street be done first.

Q2. What are the completion dates for the project?

A2. As shown on the agenda, which was not distributed until after the question was asked, the expected Construction Start date is approximately January 16, 2019, so the expected completion date is May 16, 20126. The City is aware that the project is being started during the colder months of the year when asphalt may not be available. Therefore, project delays related to the lack of available asphalt, or delays related to temperatures being below the allowable temperatures for pouring concrete will be considered, as long as they are documented and requested in a timely manner. Requests for delays related to cold weather must be requested in writing within 7 days of the actual delay.

Q3. What are the procedures for coordinating traffic control where needed.

A3. Traffic control will need to be coordinated with Ben Taylor with the City of Chattanooga Transportation department. Generally the contractor will send Mr. Taylor a proposed sketch showing the desired traffic control measures, and Mr. Taylor will approve, suggest revisions, or deny the traffic control measures suggested. Once an agreement has been reached, The City Department of Transportation will prepare a final traffic control plan to be followed by the contractor. Construction at the Marina will require lane closures, which must be scheduled so as to not impact public events. Coordinate with Ben Taylor on the City's special events calendar.

Q4. Will the agenda that was distributed at the Pre-Bid meeting be distributed with the first Addendum?

A4. It is attached.

Q5. Are winter mix designs included in the City of Chattanooga specs? If not, would they be considered as an option?

A5. The Chattanooga City concrete specification refers to ACI 306 for temperatures at time of placement. The City would entertain other mix designs depending on current weather conditions and industry standards practices.

Q6. Can you clarify the Weather Delay Specification?

A6. City Standard Specification 01035, WEATHER DELAYS, contains information regarding weather delays for construction projects. There are a number of days each month included in a Standard Baseline, which are days where suspension of construction activities are expected to occur based on adverse weather conditions. These adverse conditions are defined in terms of precipitation, freezing temperatures, and standing snow. There is certainly the possibility that weather conditions may exist that do not meet the "Standard Baseline" conditions but may still prohibit construction activities, particularly conditions that may prohibit placement of asphalt or concrete. If such an event were to occur, the City will entertain requests for additional days beyond the Standard Baseline based on specific conditions that are encountered during construction. The delay must be specific and beyond the contractor's control, and the task affected must be on the critical path. Requests for additional time must be requested in writing within one week of the occurrence of the conditions causing the request.
