PROCUREMENT FOR: Grinding/Chipping of Yard Waste, Land Clearing Debris & Clean Wood

This addendum will amend IFB No. 20-087, **Grinding/Chipping of Yard Waste, Land Clearing Debris & Clean Wood** originally issued on Wednesday, October 28, 2020. This clarification is being provided to all known and registered correspondents in response to questions received. Question #1: The IFB states "Grinding/Chipping..." Is it up to the contractor to choose which action to perform? Some companies have machines that only chip and not grind and vice versa.

Response: **The Scope of Services shall be modified to specify the material must be tub ground.**

Question #2: How close to the grinding area is/will be the windrow area? Is it in close proximity or will the contractor have to move material a significant distance?

Response: **The windrow area is approximately 500 feet from the stockpile of unground materials**

Question #3: Are there/will there be any safety meetings and/or orientations held before grinding/chipping begins?

Response: There are no required safety meetings or site orientations prior to operations, however the vendor is encouraged to coordinate with Environmental Services Manager, Landfill Supervisor, and Crew Chief. The successful vendor should feel free to raise safety or operational issues with the Landfill staff to ensure safe site operations.

Question #4: Which company had the contract last?

Response: The contract is currently held by Martin Edwards & Associates of Linden, NC. The County has a five-year maximum cap on contract terms under the Purchasing Ordinance, and the service is up for re-solicitation.
