Arlington County's Request for Proposals No. 23-DTS-RFP-201 for System Integration Services for Oracle Cloud Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) is amended as follows:

1. Reference Proposal Due Date: Change to:

ELECTRONIC SEALED PROPOSALS WILL BE RECEIVED BY ARLINGTON COUNTY VIA VENDOR REGISTRY, UNTIL 2 P.M. ON THE 31st DAY OF AUGUST 2022. IN ORDER TO SUBMIT A RESPONSE TO THIS REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL, VENDORS ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER ON VENDOR REGISTRY. NO RESPONSES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE PROPOSAL DUE DATE AND TIME.

2. Reference page 1. Notice for authority to transact business section is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with:

NOTICE: ANY OFFEROR ORGANIZED AS A STOCK OR NONSTOCK CORPORATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, BUSINESS TRUST OR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, OR REGISTERED AS A LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP, MUST BE AUTHORIZED TO TRANSACT BUSINESS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA PRIOR TO CONTRACT AWARD (REFER TO <u>AUTHORITY TO TRANSACT BUSINESS</u> SECTION OF THE SOLICITATION FOR FURTHER INFORMATION).

- 3. Reference V. Proposal Requirements, Section 7. Proposal Submittal Elements, Item C.3. Firm Industry and Oracle ERP Cloud Experience and References (Response Section 1), is hereby replaced in its entirety with:
 - C.3. Provide two ERP projects for a state or local government US entity within the past five (5) years for which your firm was the prime contractor. A minimum of one of these projects shall be Oracle Cloud ERP projects. The second project could be any ERP implementation project (not exclusively Oracle Cloud i.e., it can be an on-premises or cloud ERP project but in a state or local government entity), with the project scope including the planning, design, build, testing, training, deployment, and go-live and stabilization support of Finance and HCM requirements similar in scale to those listed in **Attachment A**.

If the second project is <u>not</u> an Oracle Cloud ERP, provide the third project with an Oracle Cloud ERP implementation for the project scope listed above for any entity. The third project does not have to be state or local government if the third project is needed.

The following clarifications are made as a result of vendor inquiries:

 We read that the County has requested for proof of authority to transact business in the state of VA in the proposals/prior to submitting the proposals. We respectfully request the County to consider if we can provide this requirement during shortlisting stage instead of the proposal submission stage.

Answer: Please see revisions above in this Addendum No. 1.

- 2. As part of Proposal, the Offeror shall include "...three ERP projects for a state or local government entity within the past five years for which your firm was the prime contractor" (page 20).
 - a. Can we provide references to projects where we were the sole technical vendor (but not the project "prime")? Answer: No, the firm providing references to projects must be the prime contractor.
 - b. Can these projects include implementation of an "on premise" solution (rather than Cloud)? Answer: Please see revisions above in this Addendum No. 1.
- Would the County consider a seperate proposal response for Change Management Services given the importance of Change Management for this project? Answer: No, the County will not consider a separate proposal response for Change Management Services. The Offeror shall provide a response to Change Management Services in their response to this RFP.
- Will Arlington County consider granting a two-week extension of the proposal due date? Answer: Please see above in this Addendum No. 1. New Proposal Due date is August 31, 2022, at 2:00 PM.
- Will the county consider an extension to the proposal submission deadline? Answer: Please see above in this Addendum No. 1. New Proposal Due date is August 31, 2022, at 2:00 PM.
- Considering that we only have another 15 more days before the submission, i want to request Arlington County to extend the RFP by at least 1 or 2 weeks.
 Answer: Please see above in this Addendum No. 1. New Proposal Due date is August 31, 2022, at 2:00 PM.
- Who is the current vendor that is providing Managed Service Support for the existing Oracle environment?
 Answer: Mythics Inc. is the current vendor providing Managed Service Support for the existing Oracle environment.
- Will the current Managed Service Support vendor be involved in supporting the selected implementation vendor on behalf of the County side? Answer: No, the County team will be supporting implementor.
- 9. Is the current managed service vendor able to submit a response to this RFP? Answer: Yes, the current managed service vendor does not pose a conflict to any response from Offerors as the work is not in line with the scope of this RFP.
- 10. Was a migration assessment conducted? If so, will the County provide the assessment to vendors? Will the Firm who conducted the assessment be allowed to respond to this bid?
 Answer: No, a migration assessment was not conducted. Please reference Attachment B Applications, Integrations, Customization, Data Conversions and Reports
- Please let us know if all the activities are to be completed on-site at the County offices, or can some activities be completed at off-site or off-shore locations.
 Answer: The Contractor shall provide the work remotely from any location provided they work

- c. Can the county confirm that all of these licenses will be directly procured by them and not to be included in vendor costing?
 Answer: The County will procure the licenses independently; licenses shouldn't be included in the Offeror's proposed cost unless the Offeror is proposing to use any additional tools. (See Attachment D, TAB "Tool")
- 13. Clarification request for PAST PERFORMANCE: "State or Local government entity" As part of the Proposal, the Offeror shall include "...three ERP projects for a state or local government entity within the past five years for which your firm was the prime contractor" (page 20). Can we provide references to projects where we were the prime contractor for projects that were completed in North America (including Canada) for the equivalent of a Canadian State or Local government entity?

Answer: No, the prime contractor project references must U.S State or Local government. The County will not accept projects of North America (including Canada). Please see # 3 above.
