

Spartanburg School District 2 RFQ1811 Epson Projectors & Installations

ADDENDUM 2

January 19, 2017

This Addendum #2 is being released to address questions that were submitted. Due to the delay in the issuance of this information, the bid due date has been postponed to January 31, 2018 at 2:00PM.

- 1. What type of connectivity would you like installed for the teacher to connect to? A wall mounted HDMI and Cat6. We are open to other solutions if you would like to propose them, including cost.
- 2. IV. SCOPE OF SOLICITATION/SPECIFICATIONS states that contractor must have a licensed electrician on staff and may not subcontract any work. Will it be acceptable to sub out the High Voltage Work for this Bid? You may sub out work, however, the bidder assumes all responsibility for any issues that arise out of subcontracting.
- 3. May we visit a school before the bid is due to view a "typical" classroom? If desired, you may contact Jason Paddock at <u>Jason.Paddock@spartanburg2.k12.sc.us</u> to arrange a site visit.
- 4. Can you provide an approximate count of projectors to be installed at each school per visit? We have no way of estimating this as it will depend upon funding.
- 5. Will an Epson 100" Diagonal Whiteboard Cost need to be included in the bid? Whiteboards need to specific size for viewing purposes to pair with Epson 695wi projectors. No.
- 6. The last item in Attachment B request cost for "Hourly Rate for additional services". May we have a description of "additional services"? Anything that arises outside of the scope of the project that we have quoted. This may be quoted as Technician I, Technician II, etc, depending on the level of service needed.
- 7. For installations that require removal of existing equipment, is the winning bidder responsible for disposal of old equipment or will the district dispose of that equipment? The winning bidder may use the dumpsters on-site at each location.
- 8. I want to confirm this bid is for the Epson 695Wi. There are a couple of points in the RFP that state 595Wi, which is end of life, and then other points that direct to the 695Wi? Yes, the bid is for the Epson 695wi.
- 9. In Section 22. the district will allow subcontracting, but in section IV." Scope of Solicitation/Specifications" it mentions the contractor must have licensed Electrician staff and may not subcontract any work. Must VAR's subcontract out electrical and provide

low voltage work. Will Spartanburg 2 consider a subcontractor for the electrical only, if approved by the district based on the wording in section 22.? See #1.

- 10. What is the full scope of work for the Electrician in regards to this project?
 - a. Would we be required to pull new electrical wire homeruns from electrical closets which would require new conduit, Junction boxes, and electrical inspections? No, you will pick up a 100 circuit from a wall socket.
 - b. How many rooms would need electrical power installed? We are unsure as this is an open ended bid, not for a specific project.
 - c. Are we to install electrical work per OSF or local building code? This will not be inspected by OSF, so we would follow the National Electric Code recommendations.
 - i. If per OSF the district will need to work with us to schedule the required inspections. n/a
 - ii. If per local building code will the district be responsible for obtaining the building permit or will that be the contractors responsibility? From our understanding, permitting will not be required.
 - iii. When can a site-visit be scheduled to view the different installation scenarios listed in the RFP? See #3
- 11. What is to be done with the old projectors and interactive boards once removed? See #7
- 12. When referring to whiteboard are these interactive or just standard dry erase boards? A standard 4'x6' magnetic whiteboard
- 13. In the removal of the ceiling mounted projectors is it the district intent for the full assembly to be removed and a new acoustical ceiling tile be installed in the in that location? We will provide the ceiling tile to be put up in the location where the assembly is removed.
- 14. What would the work hours be for work areas where students and teachers are present? Contractors can work from dismissal until 10pm when the custodial staff leaves the school
- 15. Can we use the school dumpsters for trash removal and cardboard containers for recycling, or would the district prefer we dispose of all trash offsite? See #7
