Prospective Respondent,

This Addendum forms a part of the RFP Package Document dated September 1st, 2021, with the amendments and additions noted below (deletions are shown by strikethrough and additions are underlined.)

Josie Dressendofer, Slice Wireless Solutions

Question: Do each of the areas have electricity?

Response: Each area identified has power within reasonable distance. In area #1 the batting cages and the bathrooms both have power. In area #2 the Parkview Café has power as does the adjacent groundskeeping facility. In area #3 the light poles have power and we have access to the poles. In area #4 the gazebo and bathrooms have power. In area #5 the parking lot has light poles.

Question: Is more secure hardwiring preferred or less cables more preferred using microwave point to point capability?

Response: This is difficult to answer. In a perfect world with ample line-of-sight and less tree canopy we would prefer wireless point-to-point vs. trenching and cabling. But, CRP has an extensive tree canopy and complex layout. If, based on your team's engineering experience, you believe any of the chosen areas can be served sufficiently with point-to-point backhauls then that's up to you to justify. Feel free to explore the park as many times as necessary to determine your approach.

Question: Can cables be run either on outside or it is expected they would be buried?

Response: Cables run inside a facility should be run to code and secured from tampering. Remember this park has lots of children running around. Cables run across large distances between facilities should be run with this in mind as well.

Question: Do you want us to include a monthly managed service agreement?

Response: The Village is not seeking managed services to maintain the day-to-day operations of the network at this time. The IT Division requires an administrative portal and credentials to access and manage the network over the internet 24/7/365.

Question: In the RFP there is verbiage "The Company must have a valid Village of Palmetto Bay business license and tax certificate before execution of the contract, if applicable".

Response: Miami-Dade County Business license is sufficient.

All addenda created will be incorporated into the final contract and must be acknowledged in all proposals.
