## SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1. Contractor must be able to provide Repair and/or Parts of the equipment listed to the requesting departments, which meet or exceed the specifications contained in this document.
2. Contractor to provide equipment repair and/or parts for the Heavy Duty Trucks and Equipment included but not limited to the list provided in this solicitation. The contract to include any additional equipment in excess of 1 ton trucks acquired by the County throughout the contract period.
3. The fleet of Heavy Duty Equipment, as per this solicitation, begins in excess of 1 Ton Trucks.
4. Contractor shall have a facility containing equipment and personnel to service/repair the Franklin County fleet as listed in this solicitation. Franklin County may require on-site service/repair on an as needed basis. In addition, the County may elect to purchase parts only and repair/ perform maintenance ourselves.
5. Repair and parts for the listed equipment, to include but not limited to, electrical system repair, brake system repair, exhaust system repair, transmission and drive train repair, heavy duty track repair or replacement, general maintenance, hydraulic components, all installed emergency equipment and/or any additional parts and/or services needed by Franklin County to maintain their equipment fleet.
6. Parts supplied shall be brand specific to the equipment requiring repair, unless otherwise specified by Franklin County.
7. Franklin County is aware it may not be possible for one contractor to service the entire fleet.
8. *Contractor is required to indicate on "Attachment 2" the equipment they have the capability to service/repair/obtain parts. By indicating the capability to service/repair/obtain parts for specified vehicles-it is understood the vendor has the capability to do so for MOST or ALL parts/services needed for the specified equipment. If there are exceptions, it is the responsibility of the vendor to submit the exceptions along with the bid.*
9. Franklin County reserves the right to perform our own repairs, and may order parts only at any time.
10. Parts pricing to be MSRP minus percentage discount. Pricing to include shipping cost to vendor location.
11. The contractor agrees to provide Franklin County with an estimate of the repair/parts needed within 3 business days, or less, of receipt of equipment.
12. The Franklin County departments depend on their vehicle/equipment fleet for daily operations. In the event that a Contractor cannot service the County as agreed upon per the solicitation requirements, written notification shall be provided.

13. Contractor must be able to provide service to all locations/departments necessary. Normal business hours are Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 a.m. (CST). However, these times must be verified with the requesting department. County observed holidays will be provided upon request.

# INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. The Contractor shall furnish County with a certificate of insurance indicating proof of the following insurance from company's license in the State of Missouri:
  - A. Worker's Compensation and Employers' Liability: Worker's Compensation Statutory in compliance with the Compensation law of the State and Employers' Liability Insurance with a limit no less than \$1,000,000.00 each accident.
  - B. Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include, but not be limited to, the following coverage.
    1. Premises – Operations
    2. Products and Completed Operations
    3. Broad Form Property Damage
    4. Contractual
    5. Personal Injury
  - C. Automobile Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include coverage for all the following:
    1. Owned Automobiles
    2. Hired Automobiles
    3. Non-Owned Automobiles
  - D. The certificate shall list the Certificate Holder and Address as follows: Franklin County, 400 E Locust Street, Room 206, Union, Mo 63084. The services provided to Franklin County shall be listed under "Description of Operations."
  - E. Such insurance shall include under the General Liability and Automobile Liability policies Franklin County, its employees, elected officials, representatives, and members of its board and/or commissioners as "Additional Insured's".
2. The Agreement of Insurance shall provide for notice to the County of amendment or cancellation of insurance policies 30 days before such amendment or cancellation is to take effect.

## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

### 1. E-Verify

Completion of Affidavit of Work Authorization and provide acceptable documentation of enrollment in the program.

### 2. Employment of Unauthorized Aliens Prohibited

a.) Vendor agrees to comply with Missouri Revised Statute Section 285.530.1 in that it shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the State of Missouri.
