## Biosolid Roll-Off Services

- **2.3.C Required Submittal.** Bidders shall submit the entire IFB document (all pages).
- **2.3.E Sealed Bids.** The City only accept bids electronically through Vendor Registry.
- **2.4.A Inquiries.** Any question related to the IFB, including any part of the Specifications, Scope of Work or other Contract Documents, shall be posted on Vendor Registry or sent to Jill Lin via email.



## Biosolid Roll-Off Services

- **3.1 Term.** 1 year (initial term) + 4 one-year renewal options.
- **3.15.W Cooperative Purchasing.** Specific eligible political subdivisions and nonprofit educational or public health institutions are permitted to utilize procurement agreements developed by the City, at their discretion and with the agreement of the awarded Contractor.



# Scope of Work Summary

## Detailed Scope of Work starts on page 20

- Contractor shall provide nonhazardous waste removal, transport and disposal services for WRF.
- The WRF houses two Humboldt/Bird biosolids dewatering centrifuges. The City is currently producing nonhazardous Class B biosolids and grit from the preliminary treatment process. The estimated amount is 4,000 - 7,000 wet tons of biosolids and 50 - 80 tons of grit on an annual basis.
- The resulting Contract is intended to be an indefinite quantity and indefinite delivery contract for the Services based on the City's needs. The City does not guarantee any minimum or maximum amount of Services will be requested by the City pursuant to the Contract.
