City of Beaufort, SC Questions and Answers Related to RFP 2018-108 Washington Street Park Restrooms

- 1. Do you have a site plan to show where the utility connections are available that we can connect to? Water/Sewer/Electricity. I attached the water/sewer availability map from BJWSA. Electricity is also available on Greene Street
- 2. Google earth shows a set of monkey bars where the concrete slab is to be removed. Do you want to save the equipment, or can we destroy it during the demo? This equipment should be saved.
- 3. Do you want the side walk to terminate at the gate from the restroom or be extended to the curb/existing sidewalk along the street. Be extended to the sidewalk on Greene Street; the fence would be removed, as needed, by the city.
- 4. Is there a need for a hot water heater or base board heating (freeze protection) for the restroom. Yes, a tankless, wall-mounted hot water heater, Eemax SP3512 or equal, and insulated pipes will be required.
 - 5. What type of sink and toilets are to be installed? Sink and toilets should be an industrial grade.
 - 6. Is a soap dish required? Yes.
 - 7. What type of hand drying mechanism is preferred? An electric hand dryer.
- 8. Are any lights required on the structure? Yes, lights should be installed on the front and rear of the building. Can or pendent lights mounted to the ceiling of the porch would be acceptable for the front.
 - 9. Is an electric meter need to be included? Yes, it should be installed on the back of the building.
 - 10. Is there a Sewer Tap Fee? The city will pick up the charge for any water- or sewer-related fees.
- 11. Who is responsible for the DOT encroachment permit for any water or sewer work? The city will submit this encroachment permit.
- 12. Are door locks needed? Yes, the type of preferred lock is identified in the RFP. There should be a key lock for the Service door at the rear of the building.
 - 13. Is a bid bond required? Yes, Bid Bonds are a requirement.
