The following are amendments to the RFP #320-18 Inmate Food Services:

- 1. It has been brought to Purchasing's attention that the current contractor provides employee meals. If your company wishes to offer employee meals, please include a menu, including calorie count for each meal in Tab J, Requested Samples. Please advise if all items will be available 7 days per week/ 3 times a day. Please advise if there will only be daily specials provided Monday Sunday and if so, the items of each meal that will be served for breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. Take care to ensure no pricing is included in this section. Please include the attached pricing sheet otherwise known as Proposer's Price Proposal Form Sheet C. Please list each item that would be available to staff and cost of each item. Ensure Sheet C is included in the separate sealed envelope marked with the Solicitation Name, Company Name and Price Proposal.
- 2. The RFP opening date is August 20, 2018, at 10:30 a.m.
- 3. A performance bond in the amount of 100% of the contracted price may be in effect through the life of the contract and may be added to the executed contract with the awarded proposer. A sample is attached. A clause may be added to the sample contract within this RFP document to include the following:

Surety Bonds

13.3.1 The Contractor shall furnish a performance bond, Exhibits "D", to the Owner. The bond shall set forth a penal sum in an amount not less than the contract Price. The bond furnished by the Contractor shall incorporate by reference the terms of this Contract as fully as though they were set forth verbatim in such bonds. In the event the Contract Price is adjusted by Change Order executed by the Contractor, the penal sum of both the payment bond and the performance bond shall be deemed increased by like amount. The payment and performance bonds furnished by the Contractor shall be in form suitable to the Owner and shall be executed by a surety, or sureties, reasonably suitable to the Owner.

This development has brought the need to add a line item for the cost of the performance bond.

4. All other dates, specifications, terms and conditions remain the same as posted in the RFQ document.

The following are questions and answers to the RFP #3201-8 Inmate Food Services:

QUESTION: In the RFP, it states that technical and cost proposals are to be packaged separately. However, can each individual proposal be packaged into one single box so that only one package is delivered to your office vs. two?

ANSWER: Proposers need to ensure that the Price Proposal is in a separate sealed envelope with **RFP #3201-8 Inmate Food Services, Company Name and Price Proposal** written on the outside of the envelope. The individual technical proposals do not need to be in separate sealed envelopes. The entire submission may be sent in one box. Proposers need to adhere to the requirement that no price can be submitted with the technical response.

QUESTION: Page 11, Bullet # 7 – Please clarify. RFP States that no staff meals are required. However, Summit is currently providing staff meals. Does the county wish to continue this or would the county prefer not to receive proposed staff menus?

ANSWER: Please see #1 of the amendment to RFP #320-18 Inmate Food Services above.

QUESTION: Page 12, Kitchen Facility & Equipment – It states that "There be instances & exceptions where supplies will be needed.". Will the county please clarify if the contractor will be required to purchase replacement supplies?

ANSWER: The Contractor may be required to supply disposable cups.

QUESTION: Can the county also clarify the following - With regard to what dispute resolution Dawson County intends to use. Page 43, #89, it indicates that "any disputes arising under the terms and conditions of this Contract shall not be subject to mediation or arbitration. Then on page 77, #14.6, "Litigation and Arbitration" 14.6.1 it indicates that "The Owner and the Contractor agree to resolve through negotiation, mediation or arbitration any disputes between the parties arising out of or relating this Contract and Agreement."

ANSWER: The verbiage in the contract enclosed within the RFP document, #14.6 Litigation and Arbitration will be followed by Dawson County.

QUESTION: What type of diets are currently provided?

ANSWER: Heart Healthy, Pregnancy, Diabetic and Clear Liquid. The Detention Center also serves allergenic diets.

QUESTION: What type of religious diets are available?

ANSWER: The Detention Center does not currently serve beef or pork. Occasionally an inmate is received at the Detention Center with a religious belief unbeknownst to the Detention Center

staff. Upon verification of dietary restrictions, the information is relayed to the kitchen staff to fulfill.

QUESTION: Please clarify the duties of the inmate workers in the kitchen.

ANSWER: Inmate workers are utilized for cleaning, food preparation, placing food on trays, placing and taking food out of cold storage/freezer storage/dry storage. Inmate workers are not utilized to cook the food.

QUESTION: Why only three inmate workers in the kitchen?

ANSWER: Depending upon inmate population, inmate classification and other areas of assignment throughout the County, there may be times when more than three (3) inmate workers could be made available for special needs on a case by case basis. However, do to the size of the kitchen and the number of staff on hand to monitor the inmate workers, a permanent increase in inmate workers will not be allowed.

QUESTION: What is y	our preference for the cold meal to be served (breakfast, lunch or dinner?
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ANSWER: Lunch.
