Addendum 01 August 3, 2022 IFB 23-B0005 Office Renovation

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to IFB 23-B0005 for Office Renovation, dated July 21, 2022, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory site visit.

- The project will cover approximately 720 750 square feet, including minor demolition, walls, HVAC, lighting, windows, electrical, flooring, etc. The project does not involve plumbing.
- Work hours will be 7:30AM 5:00PM, Monday through Friday. Due to the pressing need for this office space, Contractor will be expected to start work as soon as project is fully awarded.
- If it becomes necessary to shut off power, Contractor must contact Jay Hood beforehand by calling 843-655-1854.
- Water repellent will be elastomeric paint. Joint sealant will be MP150.
- The HVAC unit will be a 3-ton mini-split system from a national manufacturer; model to be current in production and availability.
- Exterior metal steel studs will be 6 inches. Interior steel studs will be 4 inches.
- Ceiling insulation will be six (6) inches thick and not twelve (12) inches thick as previously stated.
- Contractor will be responsible for installing electrical outlets and phone jacks at each
 work station that connect to the conduit. City IT will be responsible for running the
 wires.
- Lighting will be 2x4 LED on dimmer switches. Drywall will be 5/8 commercial grade.
- The wood door stored in the warehouse can be used as an office door with a metal frame.
- Flooring will be LVT commercial grade. City must approve all flooring samples before any installation work begins.
- Contractor will provide three (3) 10-lb. fire extinguishers to meet building code.
- Space is available for a roll-off container. Parking spaces can be blocked off in the parking lot.
- The performance period is ninety (90) calendar days. Any delays due to delivery of materials must be communicated to the project manager immediately.
- The City will be responsible for inspections and permit fees. Contractor will be responsible for all other licenses and fees, including a City business license.

- The designated construction entrance is also a fire exit and thus must remain clear at all times.
- The exterior color must match the rest of the building.
- Any contractor who desires a second visit to inspect the work area prior to submitting a bid must make an appointment with Jay Hood by calling 843-655-1854.
- Additional questions are due no later than 12:00 noon on Wednesday, August 10, 2022. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to asowers@cityofmyrtlebeach.com All questions received by the deadline will be answered via addendum.
- Sealed bids are due in the Purchasing Office no later than 2:00PM (local time) on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. No electronic submissions will be accepted. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.
