Manhole Lining 2022

The purpose of this Addendum #02 to IFB 22-B0037 for Manhole Lining, dated June 2022, and previously amended on June 13, 2022, is to answer the following questions:

1. Is there a way to add a line item for excessive grouting, possibly anything over six tubes of grout?

Yes, a revised bid tab is attached and is hereby made a part of this addendum.

2. Would the City allow the Warren 301-14 Epoxy in lieu of the listed polyurea material for the manhole rehabilitation?

No, the City will not allow the Warren 301-14 Epoxy in lieu of the listed polyuria material. The City desires to stay with a 500 mil polymer stress skin panel liner system.

3. Will chimney seals be required between the existing manhole casting and the new liner system?

No, chimney seals will not be required between the existing manhole casting and the new liner system.

4. Will cored pull test be required to verify proper adhesion and mil thickness?

No, cored pull test will not be required to verify proper adhesion and mil thickness.

5. Do you have photos of the existing wet well interior to be coated?

No, photos of the existing wet well interior are not available.

6. Is a South Carolina contractor's license required?

Yes, a South Carolina contractor's license is required.

Contractor must acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the bidding documents. Failure to do so is just cause for disqualification.

Sealed bids are due no later than Thursday, July 7, 2022 at 2:00PM (local time.) No electronic submissions will be accepted. The City is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.

B. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: Should the Contractor fail to substantially complete the work under this contract within the stipulated time as he has set forth in "Time of Completion" paragraph above, plus any additional days that may result from extension of time granted by the Architect/Engineer, he agrees that the Owner may retain the sum of \$500 per day for each succeeding calendar day that the Owner is deprived of full use of any or all phases of the project. This amount is agreed upon as a reasonable and proper measure of Liquidated Damages which the Owner sustains per day by failure of the contractor to complete the work within the time stipulated; it being recognized by the Owner, the Contractor, and the Architect that the injury to the Owner which could result from failure by the contractor to complete on schedule is uncertain and insusceptible to certain computation, and this sum is not to be construed in any sense as a penalty.
