- 1. Page 3, 1.8 **Bonds** please confirm a payment bond and performance bond will be required in the amount of 100% of first year annual price?
  - a. Yes.
- 2. Please confirm the expectation of staffing on-site within the facility is only at 12 hours per day, 7 days per week. (Note, page 4, 2.0 **Scope of Work**, under staffing, the On-Call Staff for 84 hours per week these are not on-site staff members).
  - a. Correct. Onsite staffing will be 12 hours per day 7 days a week. The On-Call Staff just needs to be a number where a nurse can be reached after hours.
- 3. Page 5, 2.0 **Scope of Work**, please indicate the last on-site MAG audit completed, and the next scheduled MAG audit to be completed.
  - a. Last MAG audit was completed on 8/4//21, next will be due end of April this year.
- 4. Page 10, 5.14 **Insurance**, the limits of insurance for General Liability are higher than standard limits, would the county consider alternative limits (stated is \$1m/\$6m)?
  - a. Yes.
- 5. Page 10, 5.14 **Insurance**, please confirm any limits for Professional Insurance requirements (medical malpractice).
  - a. Professional liability or medical malpractice insurance policy, as the case may be, in an amount of at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000) coverage per occurrence and three million

- dollars (\$3,000,000) aggregate.
- 6. Can the County provide any statistical information for fiscal year 2021 and year to date 2022 regarding the following:\*
  - a. Number of inmates seen by month for intake screening;
  - b. Number of inmates seen by month for nursing sick call triage;
  - c. Number of inmates seen by month for Provider sick call;
  - d. Number of inmates on average by month that are on medications;
  - e. Number of inmates on average on suicide watch;
  - f. Number of inmates seen by month by Psychiatrist;
- \*This information is not available at this time.
  - 7. Please state the times in which medications are usually passed within the facility, and the amount of time each medication pass takes (i.e. 1 hour, 2 hours, etc.).
    - a. Medication is passed out at 8am and 5pm they take approximately an hour depending on population. Also, blood sugar checks are done at 5:50am before 6am meal.
  - 8. It is noted the Vendor will manage claims process and accounting for off-site healthcare services is there a process in place now, and if so, is there a catastrophic limit or outside cost pool in place?
    - a. Yes, there is currently a process in place. The entire process is handled by our current health services provider.
  - 9. The RFP states 1 original and 3 copies of the proposal. To clarify this means 1 original of Volume 1 and 2, plus 3 copies of Volumes 1 and 2?
    - a. Yes.
  - 10. The RFP states that Volumes 1 and 2 are to be packaged and sealed separately. To clarify, proposers are to send 2 separate packages/boxes to the county?
    - a. Both volumes can be inside the same delivery box/package but must be packaged separately inside that delivery box/package. The volumes must be able to be opened completely separately.
