- 2. Would the awarded vendor be able to receive a sample data file before the live data was ready so they could build the program in advance of the live mailing? Yes, we refer to the sample data as a "test file" in the specific requirements.
- 3. Would the postage reimbursement within 21 days from invoice be included in the contract/purchase order when awarded? Yes, there will be one purchase order for the total project.
- 4. Can you confirm the size of the forms? It looks like the sample provided is 8.5×14 but the bid states 8.5×11 ? The form we are bidding is 8.5×11 . In the previous years the form has been larger, thus the sample is larger with some data marked out.
- 5. Do the forms have a perforation at the bottom? There appears to be a dotted line? The new forms for this project will not have a perforation.
- 6. If the forms do have a perforation, are #9 envelopes needed? If you do include #9's can you provide the print specifications? NA
- 7. Can you confirm if these notices will mail out First Class, Standard or Non-profit rates?
