

Bid #2007 – Pharmaceuticals for Anderson County Emergency Medical Services

2nd set of Questions & Answers

1. It is stated that “Bidders must provide an option to return pharmaceuticals 30 days prior or 30 days after expiration for an exchange at discounted price.” All pharmaceuticals, items with expiration dates, and items that are subject to FDA tracking requirements are not allowed to be returned. We would only accept returns for pharmaceuticals if it was an error on our part. Would you be willing to remove this language or allow us to take an exception against it that would not penalize us from being considered for award?

Answer: Exceptions may be considered.

2. Regarding Section 1 – General Terms and Conditions part 1.11, it mentions how we need to label our bid envelope/package based on total cost of the project. This seems to be more geared towards contractor work. Can you confirm if we need to comply with this requirement?

Answer: This is not an applicable requirement.

3. Regarding Section 1 – General Terms and Conditions part 1.29, it mentions “The Anderson County Purchasing Agent will review requests and make a determination to continue or cancel services.” If a price increase is not agreed upon, would the County allow for that item to be removed from the contract without having to terminate the contract?

Answer: This may be considered.
