Q: In regards to the $\frac{3}{4}$ gas solenoid valves, plans state to use local 120v as required for tap for control power Are there any considerations necessary as to which circuit the 120v tap is pulled from?

We need to pull power back to nearest panel and add new breaker

Q: What type of piping is above ceiling the new piping will tie into? In regards to the possibility of needing dielectric couplings.

The piping overhead is steel.

Q: Are valves required at every fixture whip?

No, we would like a shutoff for every line that comes off of the main in each classroom.

Q: Will any cabinet work be required by mechanical contractor to install piping? Cutting, notching, holes etc.

Yes, assume that there will be some cabinet work required.

Q: Will there be any additional fixtures needed?

Yes, we need to add 40 fixtures total in the rooms that don't currently have them.
