1. The ITB mentions height adjusters for fan shaped boards on the side court goals but they appear to be rectangular shaped and not fan. Should the vendor bid all height adjusters for rectangular goals?
  - a. The goals are currently rectangular but historical data shows that they were previously fan and the mounts were likely meant for fan. The concern is that the mounts were intended were fan backboards even though we currently use rectangular. We would like to stay with the rectangular boards.
