SPECIAL PROVISION

REGARDING

PROJECT COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

This project shall be completed in its entirety on or before the completion date shown on the cover of this proposal contract.

All lane closures must be approved in advance by the Engineer. A minimum of seven (7) days' notice must be provided in advance of any closure. Temporary lane closures will only be permitted between 7:00 AM until 6:00 PM each day. No lane closures will be allowed during Holidays, Holiday weekends, Special Events related to the area in accordance with the plans and specifications, or as directed by the Engineer.

For each hour or portion thereof, which any traffic lane remains closed in conflict with the restricted periods, the sum of \$500 per hour per lane shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages.

All lane closures and operations must be coordinated with existing construction contracts in the area and approved by the Engineer.

Work shall be substantially complete by nine months from the start date. Failure to have substantially complete work will result in daily liquidated damages per the rates set forth in Section 108.09 of the standard specifications. Assessed liquidated damages will be deducted from monies due the Contractor.

The contractor's proposed work plan for Phases 3 and 4 must be approved in writing by the Engineer prior to beginning any simultaneous work on both phases.

A segment of sidewalk is defined as the sidewalk that spans from one street to the next. Each segment of sidewalk shall be completed before beginning another segment, unless approved by the Engineer.

The contractor shall maintain customer access to all businesses during construction.
