A pre-bid conference was held on Tuesday, February 7, 2017, at the Camdenton City Hall. Following are the statements and clarifications made during the conference:

The City of Camdenton is soliciting bids for Clarifier Weir Replacement to serve the City of Camdenton, Missouri.

A Drop Box account has been established with PDF copies of the plans and specifications for use by suppliers and sub-contractors. It should be noted that the electronic files provided via Drop Box are solely for determining the general nature of the work to be bid and are not contract documents.

To bid this work, potential bidders MUST obtain plans, specifications, and bid documents directly from Darren Krehbiel Consultants, LLC, and be placed on the bidders list in order to qualify to bid this work.

The bid date is Wednesday, February 15, 2017, at 2:00 p.m., at which time bids will be opened and read aloud. Proposals are to be submitted to the Camdenton City Clerk on the forms in the specifications. Bidders shall turn in the entire specifications book with their bid. Bids need to include a bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total bid. At this time, the City of Camdenton anticipates awarding the project Tuesday, February 21, 2017.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities, and accept the lowest responsible, responsive bid.

Insurance and temporary utilities are the responsibility of the Contractor.

The completion date for this project shall be 120 consecutive calendar days from the Notice to Proceed.

There is no engineer's estimated cost range.

The original material suppliers for the waste water treatment facility, when originally built, are holding plans and can supply material. They can be contacted at:

There is no requirement to utilize their services. Contact information provided as a courtesy to the bidders.

The Contractor shall dispose of removed metal, not to be retained as part of the work, legally off of the project site.

Appurtenances are to be included in the price for the clarifier weir replacement. The bid received from the Contractor is understood to include all items necessary to complete the project at no additional cost to the City.

This is a prevailing wage rate project.

The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Section 285.525 through 285.550 RSMo. Contract award is contingent on Contractor providing an acceptable notarized affidavit stating that bidder is enrolled in, and participates in, a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted service and further stating that the Contractor does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection the contracted services.

Successful bidder shall comply with the provisions of Section 292.675 RSMo. Contract award is contingent on bidder providing an acceptable notarized affidavit stating that bidder and all subcontractors doing work in connection with the contracted services has provided its on-site employees with a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

The successful bidder will be responsible for his subcontractors and suppliers. It was noted that there will be no contract, or association, between the City and any subcontractors or suppliers.

The successful bidder will be required to have one job superintendent throughout the project on site at all times, even for subcontractor work. The job superintendent will remain the same through the project. Contractor to bid accordingly.

All bidders MUST list their proposed subcontractors and project references on the bid forms as these will be used in evaluating bids. If subcontractors are added after the bid and award, they may be rejected by the City.

The plans and specifications were then discussed.

The City will work with the successful bidder regarding the Notice to Proceed to accommodate construction schedules and still meet the needs of the City.

As stated, the bid received from the Contractor is understood to include all items necessary to complete the project at no additional cost to the City. All work and equipment will have a minimum one year warranty.

The City will supply tax exempt paperwork upon request.

Acceptable hours of operation shall be 7am to 7pm, Monday through Friday. Arrangements for access will be made through City.


The pre-bid meeting was held at the job site.
