The following question(s) (shown in italicized text) were submitted by prospective proposer(s). The City's responses are presented here (shown in bold text). The submitters' names and email addresses have been removed due to privacy requirements.

1. *What is meant by a FDACS Licensed Environmental Scientist?*
The contractor needs to be properly licensed to spray environmental herbicides.
2. *So do we leave dead trees that are standing?*
Yes. If a tree is dead and still standing, leave it. All dead trees that are lying on the ground are to be removed.

3. *Are we to bush hog and then spray?*

Grasses are so tall, approximately eight feet (8') tall, that bush hogging and/or mechanical means may be required to cut the grasses at the base. The contractor is required to haul away the debris and then cut and/or mow the remaining areas before spraying.

4. *Are maps included to the sites?*

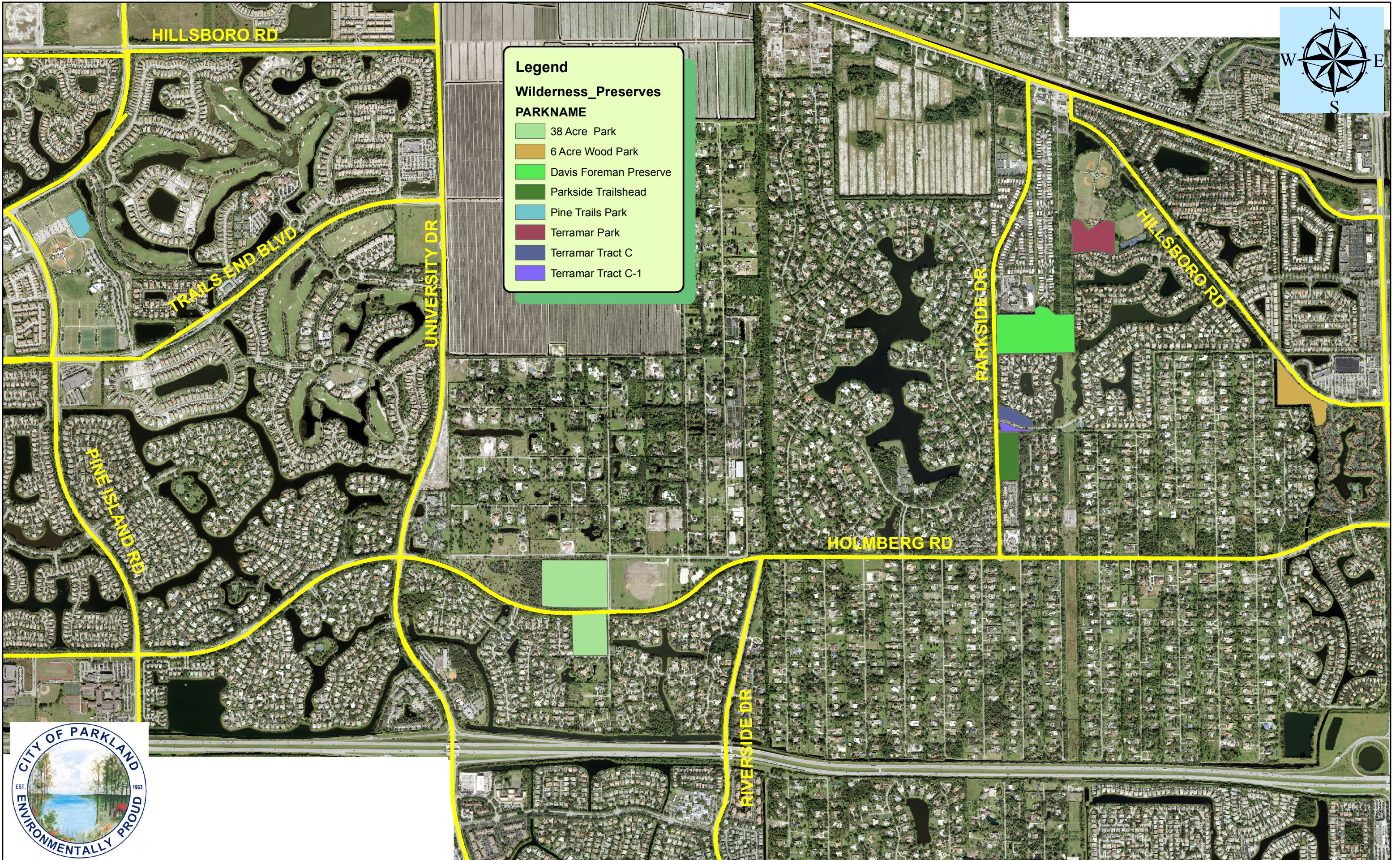
Maps were erroneously excluded from the ITB when it was initially released. Maps to each site and one overall site map are included in this addendum.

5. *Rates provided in the proposal are the rates for the term of the contract?*
