Please be advised, the new due date is May 19, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.

- Based on Addendum #1 it looks like the Bid Schedule needs to be revised to add a pay item for the High Density Mineral Bond. Please advise.
 See new bid schedule.
- 2) Based on the Variable Depth Milling quantity it looks like it includes the milling for the 2" Patching (on the Patching and Resurfacing roads identified on page 3 of Addendum #1) and the Variable Depth Milling for 3.5" and Edge Milling roads. If this is the case then the milling operation on the Patching and Resurfacing roads will be covered twice. It would simplify things if the Bid Schedule was revised to have a 2" Patching-19mm item for the Spot Patch and Top roads and a 2"-19mm item for the Patch and Resurfacing roads. Please clarify. The variable depth milling is for Edge mill and 3.5" milling. Milling is considered incidental to the patching line item. 2" Patching has been eliminated as a line item.
- On page 4 of Addendum #1 it states that the contractor will need to perform shoulder building and grassing on the Reconstruction and Resurfacing roads. What will be the width of the shoulder building?
 Establishing a 4:1 slope is optimal.
- 4) Taylor Rd. calls for 2'-19mm and 1.5"-9.5mm. There is not a pay item for the 2"19mm unless the 2"-Patching pay item covers the work. A 2"-19mm pay item is needed. Please clarify.

- 5) Will the City be putting out a revised bid schedule with revised quantities for removing Springfield Creek Way and adding Double Springs Way as well as the Pay Item for the High Density Mineral Bond? See new bid schedule for the High Density Mineral Bond. Quantities for the substitution will not change.
- 6) On the Bid schedule there's two patching Pay Items one for 2" patching and one for 3" patching. In addendum 1 it states patching at 3.5" then the question right after that it states all patches will be 3". Will the City please clarify the depth of all patching?

See question 2 above.

7) On page 3 of Addendum #1 the City of Milton has stated: Utility coordination and relocation will be handled by the contractor. Does this mean that the contractor should include the COST for relocation of any utilities in conflict or does this mean the contractor will handle the coordinating and locations with the utility companies ONLY – the City of Milton will be responsible for the cost of the relocations? Please clarify this statement.

Raising of water valves and hydrants would be considered incidental. Any others the contractor will handle the coordination and locations with the utility companies
