AGENDA ITEM#: 10 E - Bid acceptance for the interconnection of Hammock Mobile Estates, Budget Resolution No. 2018-05 and Budget Amendment No. 30

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> At your December 19, 2017 meeting, the Framework of an Agreement to acquire the sewer customer base of the Hammock Estates ROC Park was approved. Council also instructed Staff to prepare an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the Hammock Estates interconnection. On February 15, 2018, ITB #18-006 was published and on March 6, 2018 submittals for ITB #18-006 were opened (please see Attachment A – Bid Tabulation Sheet). Staff with the assistance of Polston Engineering have reviewed the bids received and can find no reason not to accept the low bid from Excavation Point in the amount of \$121,721.00 (please see Attachment B).

The approved 2017/2018 fiscal year budget does not include funds for this sewer interconnection project. Staff recommends transferring the funds required to complete this project from the Utilities Department Fund Balance account.

Attached for Council's consideration is Budget Amendment No. 30 transferring \$121,721.00 from the Utilities Department Retain Earnings / Fund Balance to the Capital Line Item established for this construction project and Budget Resolution No. 2018-05 increasing the 2017/2018 budget in the amount of \$121,721.00 to provide sufficient funding for this project.

For Council's consideration, Staff submits the following recommendations:

- 1. Accept Excavation Point's bid in the amount of \$121,721.00 to interconnect Hammock Estates and demolish existing wastewater treatment plant.
- 2. Approve Budget Resolution No. 2018-05
- 3. Approve Budget Amendment No. 30
- 4. Instruct the City's Attorney to prepare the necessary contracts for the completion of this project.
