1. Please provide the monthly tonnage for trash and also recycling by commodity. Can you provide daily, monthly, and annually by material- MSW, C, D and recyclables?

Average tons per month-

Trash:1235 tons (All waste)

Cardboard: 9.6 tons Plastic:5.2 tons Mixed paper: 5.7 tons Metal cans: 1.1 tons

- 2. What is the term of the contract?
 - a. 2 yr. with renewal option upon agreeable terms for an additional 3 years
- 3. The recycling station referred to at Barlow Transfer Station, is this the main transfer station?
 - a. yes
- 4. Is there only one recycling center?
 - a. Yes, at Barlow Rd. Transfer Station.
- 5. Additional equipment provided by Lumpkin County, is this all on site at the Transfer Station?
 - a. yes
- 6. Does the dumping of recyclables have to go to a certain place or can the vendor choose?
 - a. Vendor can choose and submit the monthly report
- 7. What materials are accepted now?
 - a. Number 1 and 2 plastics with screw lids only, aluminum cans, metal cans, cardboard, mixed paper. All are collected separately.
- 8. Please include in your proposal a process on how you would address the price increase based on changing costs.

- 9. Do you accept yard waste?
 - a. The transfer station does currently accept yard waste for citizens only, not commercial yard waste.
- 10. Is the vendor responsible for the improvements to the condition of the tipping floor?
 - a. No, the county has budgeted resurfacing of the tipping flow in 2023.
- 11. How many times per month are each container (recycling) serviced?

Services per month-Cardboard: 9 times Plastic: 6 times Mixed paper: 4 times

Metal cans: 1 time every 3 months

- 12. Are the recycling containers delivered to same facility (Gainesville) or are other sites being used as well?
 - a. Other sites are being used.
- 13. What type of commitment is required from the vendor to promote an "Anti-Litter Campaign?"
 - a. Vender to propose an anti-litter campaign as part of the proposal
- 14. Will the vendor be required to work with the College and City to expand recycling as mentioned during the pre-bid?
 - a. The vender will have the opportunity to negotiate additional work with the city, College and School District. This is not a requirement of this proposal.
- 15. What is the gate rate charged at the transfer station for commercial customers? Do they have to operate in Lumpkin County?
 - a. \$55/ton and No.
- 16. What is the rate for residential trash customers? Per bag?
 - a. Bulk by the ton at gate rate (\$5 min). bag: \$1 per bag (30 gal or smaller)
- 17. Rates for bulky items...mattresses, furniture, etc.?
 - a. Per ton rate plus \$5 per bulky item.
- 18. Is construction debris allowed?
 - a. Yes
