Question Number	Question	Answer
1.	CF 2018 - standard or enterprise License?	HCS intends to deploy the Enterprise version.
2.	Are there any java integrations or uses of Java within the CF code? A good example is using Java for file manipulation, image manipulation, networking, secure connection handling etc. Many times an application may use a <i>third party java class</i> - typically a jar file. These may need to be replaced or recoded to use something else. Knowing these exist (or not) can help our estimate.	There are no java integrations of which we are aware of.
3.	Resolve any code refactoring issues – I presume this does not mean refactoring the whole code base. Where something works and does not present a security or other issue, we leave it alone. Refactoring in this case means resolving code issues that result from the migration. Do we have that right?	Correct; where something works and does not present a security or other issue, leave it alone.
4.	Is there a code repository (Git or SVN etc)?	No there is not.
