Plyler Park Phase II

The purpose of this addendum is to answer the following questions:


1. Can "alley" at south side of project be used for staging/laydown yard for materials, etc?
 - A. Both alleys must remain open and accessible for pedestrian access, adjacent business operation, deliveries and maintenance purposes. All staging/laydown areas should be within the secure fenced area.
2. It appears that the only access to project site for loading demolition material, soil, plant material, etc. as well as unloading material to site is Ocean Boulevard. Can we block the North bound lane during daytime hours if we use proper MUCTD devices, etc?
 - A. Upon erection of a chain-link fence, Contractor may access site via the Southern alley, then drive/park/store material within the secure fenced area. Please note that any damage done to existing site features that are to remain (ie: concrete, pavers, stage, statue, electrical, landscape, etc) shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to fix/replace, at the discretion of the Owner. Contractor may not block traffic on Ocean Boulevard. All work must take place from within Plyler Park.
3. Drawing C3-concrete washout area: Where does the City intend this item to be placed?
 - A. The concrete washout area shall be located within the secure fenced area at the Contractor's discretion. The designated area must be maintained and cleaned up by the Contractor each week. No water will be allowed to exit the washout area. ALL debris and water must be contained onsite.
4. Drawing C4-Sleep Deterrent Bar Note: Please provide detail or following information.
 - (1) Thickness of Plate (Note only says 3/4" wide); (2) Length of embedment into top of concrete wall.
 - A. Please see attached detail regarding sleep/skateboard deterrent bar. This detail shall apply to both alley retaining wall and concrete benches.
5. Drawing C6-Note reference Plyler Park sign: Confirm if existing sign is to be removed and given to the City.

- A. Please disregard note on C6 referencing signage. Proposed signage is not part of this bid: however, Contractor shall remove blue metal fencing/signage on top of existing Ocean Boulevard wall during demolition and turn over to the Owner.
6. Drawing IRR1 appears to show location of existing 2" conduit/sleeve with new irrigation lines. Note at IRR1 says see conduit locations typical at drawing C5. Drawing C5 shows two each 4" conduits at similar but different locations. Please clarify if new irrigation lines are to be placed at existing sleeves or the new conduit shown on drawing C5, or are the 2" sleeves at IRR1 to be new.
- A. There is existing conduit within Plyler Park: however some of its exact location is unknown at this time. Therefore, Contractor shall install conduit as shown on C5 and disregard conduit shown on IRR1. Conduit locations on C5 are approximate and can be adjusted, with permission from the Owner. Please also see C5 for additional notes regarding conduit, including Note 7: Contractor may utilize existing conduit within the park, if empty and/or with permission from the Owner.
7. Discussions at pre-bid meeting indicated that first phase of work was to be completed by the second week of May to include as much of the concrete work as possible. Bid documents call for a 6' chain link fence around the construction site. Since this work will be completed in two phases and the entire construction area will need to be secured at both phases, we assume that the chain link fence will need to be in place for both phases. Please confirm.
- A. Yes, a chain-link fence shall be erected to provide a secure fenced area at all times where work is being done.

NOTE: Clarification item: each concrete bench shall include a sleep/skateboard deterrent bar, as shown on Doty & Sons website and per attached detail provided.

The bid date shall remain the same, 2:00 February 14, 2019
